Free Credit Scores Now Available With Credit Sense

CECU is thrilled to introduce free credit scores for members within Virtual Branch! The new service is called Credit Sense and is powered by our current partner, SavvyMoney. We are always looking for ways to save our members money. With Credit Sense you can make rate and payment comparisons to find the best deal for you.

About Credit Sense:

- It's free!
- It's a "soft pull" on your credit report and does not affect your score.
- Up to four scores per Virtual Branch login may be obtained (you, spouse, children, etc.).
- Track your score each month.

It's easy to get your score.

1. Log into Virtual Branch and click the "Get More than a Credit Score" graphic.
2. You'll fill out a short form and answer some questions to identify yourself.
3. You get your score!

Anytime you log into Virtual Branch, you can check your score by inputting the last four digits of your Social Security number. Your score will be pulled each month, and you'll receive an email letting you know if your score changed that month.

The Missouri Conservation Heritage Foundation kicked off 2017 with a celebration of 20 years supporting conservation efforts in Missouri. More than \$20 million has been invested in strategic areas that include Discover Nature Girls' Camps, MDC Nature Centers, Guided Veteran Hunts and Species of Concern and Habitat Restoration projects. Paddle Missouri! Exploring 100 Miles Of The Big Muddy

Loading their canoes and kayaks, nearly 50 participants of the first-ever PaddleMO launched their vessels into the swirling muddy waters of the Missouri River this fall.

Beginning in Hermann, Missouri, their focus was to paddle the final 100 miles of the Big Muddy, ending at its confluence with the Mississippi River.

Sponsored by Stream Teams United in conjunction with many partner organizations, including MDC and the Missouri Conservation Heritage Foundation, the five-day camping and paddling trip was not only driven by the power of the river, but also by cultural and conservation education. Paddlers ranged in age from 11 to 74. Randal Switzer and his two sons took on the adventure together.

"It was my first time to paddle a kayak. It was great!" said Randal, 70. His sons had an up-close experience with an Asian carp landing in their canoe.
